- to be over 18 years old
- to not work for one of the radio partners of Kantara magazine

### THE PRICES

A certificate recognizing the value of the photograph (technical and artistic value as well as historical and cultural value) will be delivered to the winners; Photographic accessories and presents from the radio and partner institutions.

The winning photographers will be presented in a special Kantara edition and the awarded photographs will be featured in a travelling exhibition.

### APPLICATION

To participate, just send a coherent selection of 5 maximum photos related to the bridges of the Mediterranean.

Specifications :

- Original photographs
- Name of the bridge and, if applicable, local name
- Position of the bridge (preferably GPS)
- Date of the photo
- Motivation of the choice (economic, social, historical importance, etc.)

***Photo in JPEG format and maximum size of 5 MB, with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi***

### THE JURY

The jury is composed of professional photographers appointed by institutions specialized in photography, archives, photo libraries. They come from the partner countries of the Kantara program.

The Jury is independent; the members of Kantara will not take part in the choice and in the selection criteria.

### KANTARA magazine

Kantara is a weekly radio magazine in French language, co-produced by 6 Mediterranean public radios and run under the aegis of COPEAM (Permanent Conference of the Mediterranean Audiovisual Operators).
